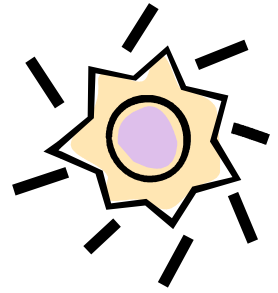

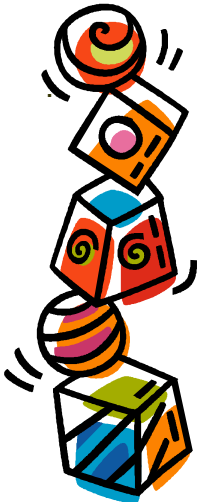
Adventure Camp



Register Now for Adventure Camp, a program specially designed to help children prepare for kindergarten. The camp day is structured much like a kindergarten classroom, where children will be able to learn and practice skills they will need to be successful. **Only 24 spaces available!!!**

The curriculum for Adventure Camp was created with the help of classroom teachers from across the district. The skills taught and practiced in camp are listening, following direction, self control, and basic academic knowledge. The teacher focuses on colors, shapes, letter sounds, and numbers, while engaging the children in play, choice time, and art projects.

This project was originally designed as a Readiness to Learn OSPI grant activity through a partnership with the Port Angeles School District.
