The **Child Check - Screener** provides the best opportunity to reach out to enable families to learn about the growth and development of their child, become their child's first teacher for school success, and offers wrap around support for families. This position covers Port Angeles and Sequim.

The **Child Check - Screener** will screen children ages 18 months to 5 years living in Clallam County for social, emotional, behavioral and developmental issues with the specific goal of providing their parents and caregivers with information about how to address concerns and access resources for parenting support and school readiness for their children.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Minimum of HS Diploma/GED or equivalent is required
- Bachelor's Degree in Mental Health plus Early Childhood Development experience or Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Development plus mental health experience is preferred
- 5+ years' experience working with parents and young children and experience assessing young children is preferred
- Must have WA State Driver License, auto insurance and reliable transportation
- Bilingual in Spanish & English is preferred
