Therefore, the United Way of Clallam County is pleased to announce a collaboration with Prevention Works! regarding the following funding opportunity.

Background

Many educational events have taken place in Clallam County with organizers and attendees from a cross-sector of agencies to inform and educate the community about Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) Trauma Informed Care, and the N.E.A.R. Sciences. At one such event, members of the community gathered to share a meal, view the film 'Resilience' and discuss priorities, common purposes, and next steps for supporting resiliency in Clallam County.

Grant Opportunity

The United Way of Clallam County has partnered with Prevention Works! to fund other events in Clallam County to raise awareness, knowledge, and practices related to ACEs and N.E.A.R. sciences. Between May 1, 2019 and March 31, 2020, six to twelve mini-grants, in the amount of \$500.00 to \$1,000.00, will be available for non-profit organizations throughout Clallam County that are organizing community-wide educational programs focused on ACEs, Trauma Informed Care and/or the N.E.A.R. Sciences. Grants will be made on an on-going basis between May 1, 2019 and January 15th, 2020, or until funds are depleted.

Applications will be accepted by the 15th of each month with award announcements made by the last day of the month until funds are depleted. Reimbursement for awards will be made once the attached evaluation(s) is completed and returned, no later than 2 weeks after the program. Priority funding will be given to projects with three or more partners and to those programs outside of the Port Angeles School District. Eligible funding activities include, but are not limited to:

- Honorarium for a guest speaker or expert to speak in Clallam County
- Cost of advertising or promotion
- Food and non-alcoholic beverages
- Educational materials
- Administrative costs not totaling more than 10% of total award
